No Experience Necessary - Full Training Provided

Full Time Basic Salary - Nothing, not a bean, zilch.

Performance related bonus/commission - as above, nothing.

OTE - Again nothing.

Fuel Expenses - yes, but limited to one car.

Working Hours: Full or part time. Flexibility is required as hours include evenings and weekends. Would preferably suit retired or semi-retired member. (They've generally got more time on their hands)

This is a field based role and you will be required to visit Society waters to ensure that all anglers, members and non-members alike, adhere to Society Rules & Bye-laws at all times.

To attend any/all meeting of Bailiffs called by the Head Bailiff or his assistant. Free coffee is available but no nibbles unless you bring your own. (If you do don't sit next to Roy Stedman)

All Bailiffs are required to travel, as and when necessary and should own a reliable car or at least one that starts.

Applicants must be flexible with regards to the hours of work and must possess communication and negotiation skills with the ability to show empathy whilst being assertive. You must be able to show tolerance at all times when dealing with problems/ problem members and members of the public.

Keep lakes and banks free of rubbish.

To monitor the fisheries and report to the Head Bailiff any problems e.g. vandalism, fish welfare, water levels, routine maintenance and any safety issues.

In return you will be rewarded with:

- A badge
- The undying love and gratitude of your fellow members.
- Long walks in the countryside in all weathers,
- As much annual leave as you can handle,
- Healthcare - Tube of Savlon and box of plasters.
- Pension - yes you will definitely need that.
- Sense of humour would be helpful.
